

FirstOntario supports *Sleepless in our Cities* and raises awareness and more than \$11,000 to help tackle homelessness

On any given night, 35,000 Canadians are living homeless or unhoused

Hamilton, ON, February 23, 2021 – The United Way Hamilton and Halton's *Sleepless in our Cities* event surpassed its \$75,000 goal to raise awareness around homelessness right here in our communities. FirstOntario Credit Union was the title sponsor, but CEO Lloyd Smith wanted to take it a step further. He personally participated in the fundraising event on February 19 by sleeping in his car overnight to emphasize the importance and dire need for affordable housing.

"It's important to be able to bring awareness to an issue that has become so critical in our communities – we need to do our part to help support our neighbours who don't have a safe and secure place to call home," Smith said.

"This was just one night for me – but this is a constant reality for thousands of people who don't know where they are going to sleep and be safe. I would like to thank everyone who made donations to help with this important cause."

With the support of FirstOntario employees, Members and other generous donors in our community, Smith raised \$11,270 toward the initiative which will help to support two homeless people in a shelter for one year. The rate of homelessness per 100,000 people is 45.2 in Hamilton. This figure is even greater in Halton Region at 49.4.
